SUGGESTIONS

At Entry of the Bride:

- Bridal Chorus, from Lohengrin (by Wagner)*
- March, from Scipio (Handel)**
- Trumpet Voluntary (John Stanley)*
- Arrival of the Queen of Sheba (Handel)*** (though this is quite long, and may work better as an exit piece)

During Signing of the Registers:

- Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring (Bach)
- Air, from Water Music (Handel)
- Canon in D (Pachelbel)

At the Exit of Bride and Groom:

- Wedding March (Mendelssohn)*
- Now Thank We All Our God (Karg-Elert)** (joyful but less well known)
- Ode to Joy (Beethoven)**
- Any of the trumpet voluntaries, e.g. J Clarke, J Stanley or H Purcell make suitable entry and exit pieces*

* = traditional; ** = different; *** = problematic
- see comments above

However, anything (within reason) is possible. If you have any ideas, please feel free to ask!

Hymns:

Normally two or three hymns are sung during the service. Please consult with us regarding the hymns you wish to sing.

AFTER COMPLETING THE FORM OVERLEAF PLEASE RETURN TO THE DIRECTOR OF MUSIC (VIA THE PARISH OFFICE - ADDRESS ON THE FRONT OF THIS LEAFLET) AND THEN CONTACT HER TO DISCUSS YOUR REQUIREMENTS.

To make your special day a musically memorable one please be in touch as soon as possible to arrange an informal meeting. Usually this would take place after a Sunday service when the Director of Music will be more than happy to play extracts from the pieces on this list and answer any questions you may have.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TOO LATE! - THREE OR FOUR MONTHS BEFORE YOUR WEDDING IS IDEAL.
